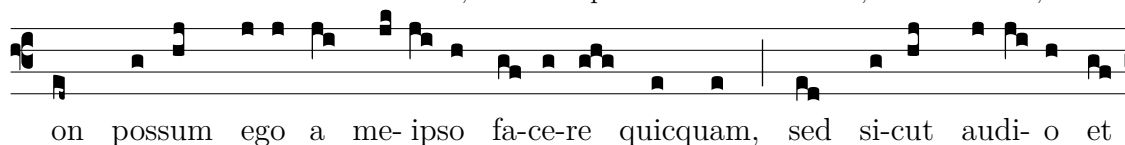

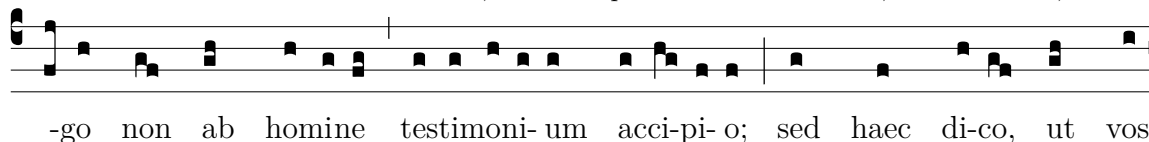

A few notes were left out and a few added.

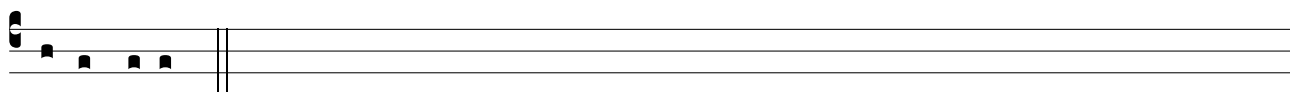
